As well, the Hebrew Bible reading will now serve as a children's story when children are




present and Karen will speak directly to them (although all are welcome to listen!) When children are not present Karen will tell the story to the congregation.

Pre-registration is necessary, so please sign-up on the sheet in the church hall. Contact Rob Brockley for more information.




Lectionary Bible Study Tuesday Mornings!


